We had a very successful year this past year despite the effect of Covid on our and all volunteer organizations. This was primarily due to the constant work and attention given to our membership renewals and new member recruitment by Mary Scalise-Annis and Bonnie Auchincloss, our Membership Vice-Presidents.

We ended the year with 253 members and 9 free members for the upcoming year as a result of 3 years of not receiving credit for our numerous new members. This was a recurring issue that was finally resolved in recent months.

One change that seems to be permanent is that our renewals will begin to be annualized as of July 1, 2023.
